




There are various misconceptions about the Gift of prophecy in the spiritual world. Being a Christian, we must discern it with scriptural evidence. Let's learn about it.



What does it mean to prophesy?

Prophecy is the messages from God to man through prophets/prophetess for the spiritual growth of the church..





 A person who is set apart for God and keeps him/herself holy and blameless and also one who controls his/her tongue so that he/she only says what God tells them to say.

Jeremiah 15:19





A person who is refined by God through many persecutions for the sake of Christ. Malachi 3:3





Significance of prophesy?

Should be according to the Word of God Revelation 22:18-19

Convicts about sin, righteousness and judgment John 16:8,
 1 Corinthians 14:24

Reveals the inner secrets of a person **Corinthians 14:24,25**

Reveals mystery and wisdom 1 Corinthians 13:2

Teaches 1 Corinthians 14:31

It provides Spiritual growth, comfort, encouragement

1 Corinthians 14:3

Reveals God's Will.

Gives glory to God John 16:14





 Springs out a river of life in someone who is dead inside John7:38,39

Builds the church and destroys(Evil works) what is required Jeremiah 1:10

Will set you free, will not be a burden
 Galatians 5:1

 Do not scoff at prophesies, test everything and hold on to what is good

1 Thessalonians 5:20,21



 Past, present and future can be prophesied Jonah 3:4, Acts 5:1-4, 8:11-21

 Should be according to the faith which was handed down to the saints Jude 1:3, Romans 12:6

 Paul says to desire for the gift of prophesy, so we need to pray for it.

1 Corinthians 14:39



Will Prophesy happen?

Holy Spirit is the one who prophesies so it will happen. But in some situations God has not made the prophesies come to pass because of disobedience of people or for people to intercede on behalf of someone or a nation



For example:

Nineveh

Jonah prophesied that Nineveh will be destroyed but because the people of Nineveh had repented God changed His will. Jonah 3



Canaan –God promised Israel that they will inherit Canaan but because of their disobedience only two people entered Canaan. Exodus 3:7-8, Numbers 32:11-12



Shipwreck- Intercession of Paul - Acts 27:10- Paul said that a great disaster will come upon the ship and their lives. Acts 27:22- later he prophesied that nothing will happen to the life of people but only to the ship.





Responsibilities of a prophet


- Pray on behalf of people **Genesis 20:7**
- Advice the people and point out their mistakes.
 Isaiah 58
- Convicts them of coming judgment and trials if they do not repent Isaiah 1:19-20
- Build their faith, encouragement, comfort
 1 Corinthians 14:3
- Predicts the future as per His will. Rev 1:1
- God reveals secrets to a prophet and he informs the people as per His will **Exodus 7:2, Amos 3:6**



Different ways a prophet can prophesy

According to the Bible let's see the different ways God can give a prophet His revelations.

- Visions Acts 10:2-7
- Dreams Number 12:6
- In their mouth Jeremiah:/9
- Writing on the wall Daniel 5:5
- Through a voice **Daniel 8:16**
- In thoughts Daniel 4:19





- Jesus Himself can come and reveal Rev 21:11
- Word of God Psalms 119:105, Jeremiah 1:9
- Through nature Jeremiah 13:7-10
- During singing 1 Corinthians 14:15 God puts songs in their mouth according to their situations and that can be a prophesy Luke 5:21-22, 7:39-48
- Can understand what is there in another person's mind



Angel Acts 27:22 Through angels God tells us His message

- God will speak through some trials and sufferings we go through- Balaam- he understood through his life situations that you shouldn't ask God for counsel more than once for the same thing with false intention. Numbers 22
- By touching your body and waking you up Daniel 8:18
